Mix with locals at Washington Square and take in a show from one of the park's street performers.

Browse the eclectic shopping of Bleeker Street, including clothing, specialty food shops, independent bookshop, music stores, and more.

Your local guide will lead the group past some of the neighborhood's most interesting architecture, from stunning Italianate brownstone to a 19th Century farm silo turned theater. From Madonna to Dylan Thomas to Bob Dylan, pass the homes and hangouts of famous writers, musicians and artists who found inspiration in this creative mecca.

Finish the New York City walking tour with a delicious pint at the White Horse Tavern, a classic NY ale house dating back to the late 1800s and frequented by many famous authors of the 20th Century.
